

Making Clovey Oranges

These simple decorations will make your home smell wonderful over wintertime.

Equipment:

1 orange per child
Large quantity of cloves: 20-50
per child
1 paper bag per child
(optional)
Ribbon (optional)



Instructions:

1. Push cloves into the orange to make a pattern, represent something, or just do it randomly! You can plan it on a piece of paper first if you wish.
2. (Optional) Tie a ribbon around the orange
3. (Optional) Place the orange in a paper bag and put in a warm dry place, such as a warm cupboard or above a radiator, for 2-3 weeks until the orange has dried out.

Use as a Christmas decoration by placing on a table or hanging on a tree - the orange and cloves should scent the air!
